SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
February 17, 2026

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of May convened a special meeting on Tuesday, February 17, 2026 at 2:00 p.m. at the May Town Hall. Those present included: Board members John Pazlar, Don Rolf, and Julie Andrich; Clerk/Treasurer Bobbi Hummel, and Deputy Clerk Treasurer Marsha Olson.

Notice was posted on the township's website and at the Town Hall more than 72 hours prior to February 17th, 2026.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the proposed 2027 Levy.

Board Chair John Pazlar opened the meeting at 2:00 p.m.

Treasurer Olson presented the proposed budget with a 5.84% increase. All line items were reviewed and minor adjustments were made to contribution commitments, future road projects, and anticipated gravel road repairs/needs.


Pazlar motions, seconded by Andrich, to present the 2027 levy at the annual meeting as \$1,228,244. A percentage increase of 5.62%. By Roll Call Vote: Pazlar YES, Rolf YES, Andrich YES. Motion passed.

Adding Board Supervisors as Authorized Signers on Township Accounts.

Pazlar motions to add Supervisor Julie Andrich and Don Rolf to the bank signature card as back up for emergency purposes. Seconded by Rolf. All in favor. Motion passed.
