SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES  
November 1, 2024**

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of May convened a special meeting on Friday, November 1, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. Those present included: Board members Steve Magner, and Don Rolf; Clerk/Treasurer Bobbi Hummel; Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Marsha Olson; Engineer Katie Koscielak.

Notice was posted on the township's website and at the Town Hall more than 72 hours prior to November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss APRA spending and 2024-25 plowing contracts.

Acting Chair Steve Magner called the meeting to order at 9:14 a.m.

Clerk/Treasurer Olson requests a motion to approve the transfer of funds from the ARPA dollars to pay for road improvements and fire contracts from this year. ARPA funds must be used prior to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024.


Olson will also request approval for a transfer of funds from the 201 Sewer fund at the regular Board meeting next week.


Magner motions to move ARPA dollars to the road and bridge fund and fire fund. Rolf seconds. All in favor. Motion passed.

The Board has received 2 bids for 2024-25 plowing services. Dresel Contracting and Miller Excavating submitted bids. There are variables and complexities to each bid that need to be examined and understood. Given the complexity, Mager asked Engineer Erichson and Attorney Snyder to re-examine the bids and come up with a final number given the guidelines of 600 hours with 2 large plow trucks.
