May Township Mailbox Policy

1. Contact the township Clerk/Treasurer immediately after the damage is noticed. Include your name, address, and approximate time of damage. Pictures of the damage are helpful.
2. The Clerk will then notify Miller Excavating so they can review the truck GPS. A Miller Excavating Supervisor will perform a site visit to view the mailbox.
3. If Miller Excavating determines that the mailbox was damaged strictly by thrown snow from a plow, no compensation will be provided.
- 4a. If Miller Excavating determines that the truck/plow actually contacted the mailbox, Miller crews will temporarily repair the mailbox until Spring. When weather permits, a Washington County standard swing-away mailbox will be installed. (See below picture)
- 4b. If the homeowner elects to repair or replace their own mailbox and it was previously determined by Miller Excavating that direct plow contact damaged the mailbox, Miller Excavating will provide reimbursement up to \$75.00.
