The Board of Supervisors of the Town of May convened a special meeting on Sunday, May 3, 2020 from 10:11 a.m. to 10:31 a.m. via virtual telephone/video conference. Those present included: Board members John Adams, John Pazlar and Bill Voedisch; and Clerk/Treasurer Linda Tibbetts.

The sole purpose of this meeting was to discuss calcium chloride application. Adams called this special meeting. Notice was posted on the website and at the Town Hall.

Adams moved, seconded by Pazlar, to apply calcium chloride to the gravel roads in the next two weeks.


