

**TOWN of MAY
WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
February 19, 2024**

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of May convened a special meeting on Monday, February 19, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. Those present included: Board members John Pazlar, Steve Magner, and Don Rolf; Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Marsha Olson, and Clerk/Treasurer Bobbi Hummel.

Notice was posted on the township's website and at the Town Hall more than 72 hours prior to February 19th, 2024.

The sole purpose of the special meeting was to review and approve the proposed 2025 levy.

Board Chair John Pazlar called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m.

The proposed levy has been reviewed by all Board members individually prior to this meeting.

The initial proposal includes re-paving Lynch Road. Estimates are \$1.8 million to complete the project. This initial draft proposes \$150,000.00 be levied every year over the next 10 years. This would mean a nearly 20% levy. Previous years have levied \$20,000 per year for this project, which would put the 2025 levy closer to 6%.

Pazlar has concerns about this and notes it is a low traffic road with about 30-40 homes on it. Perhaps an ask of \$40,000 to \$50,000 would get the township closer to the goal in 10 years.

Rolf questions why spend this much money on a road that has limited use. Don is comfortable with a 5%-6% levy.

Magner is not in support of this large of a levy. 6% is realistic, closer to 5% is better. There is some savings in plowing costs this year due to the mild winter this year. But there is still potential for snowfall. The grading used up some of those funds because grading was still being done late into the year. He is in support of lowering the gravel request from \$40,000 to \$30,000 also.



By Roll Call Vote: Pazlar YES, Rolf YES, Magner YES.


